

The Forge, High Street, Much Hadham, Hertfordshire SG10 6BS



The Forge is situated within the Forge Museum in the High Street, Much Hadham, Hertfordshire. The High Street is quite long; the Forge is opposite the Village Hall, about 150 yards south of the Bull pub. If you are coming from the north, the Bull is on your left, the Village Hall on your right and the Forge on your left.

Directions from the M11

Leave the M11 at J8. Follow signs for Bishop's Stortford initially, then the A120, then Much Hadham. You will go straight on at 5 roundabouts as you follow the Bishop's Stortford bypass. Turn right at the 6th, signposted Much Hadham, B1004. Stay on the B1004 until you get to a crossroads in Much Hadham itself; turn left into the High Street.

Look out for the Bull on your right. The Forge is about 150 yards further on on the right opposite the Village Hall. Park in the road outside the Bull or in the Village Hall car park.

Directions from the A10

Turn off onto the A120 Eastbound at Standon/Puckeridge, signposted Stansted. To avoid the single lane traffic jams at Little Hadham, turn right off the A120 at Standon after the river (signposted High Street, Shops) and follow the road until you get to a 'T' junction; turn right and you will be in Much Hadham High Street.

Look out for the Bull on your right. The Forge is about 150 yards further on on the right opposite the Village Hall. Park in the road outside the Bull or in the Village Hall car park.
